
*In the quiet moments of remembrance, we are reminded that

Prayer of Consecration: Chief Celebrant

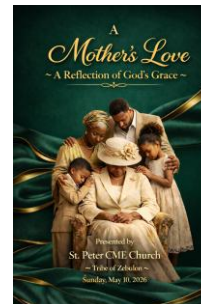
The Lord's Prayer: All
